Namibia Horticulture Trust – Goal Strategy

It is a policy of the Namibia Horticulture Trust (NHT) that there must be a strategy towards the main goal of the NHT. This strategy will also determine the Vision and Mission of the NHT and will be:

To provide food security and proper nutrition for under privileged and poor communities by empowering them to implement and sustain urban and peri-urban horticulture gardening projects. As part of these projects the NHT envisage to uplift their skills in literacy, horticulture and entrepreneurship.

To facilitate training centres where champions and administrators for these people can be trained for at least 30 months before they are introduced into community projects.

To provide skills and techniques for micro-gardening in areas of limited space to people in urban and peri-urban areas and to provide skills and techniques for conservation gardening and farming to people in peri-urban and rural areas.

To form strategic partnerships to be able to do capacity building in under privileged and poor communities to become self-sustainable.
